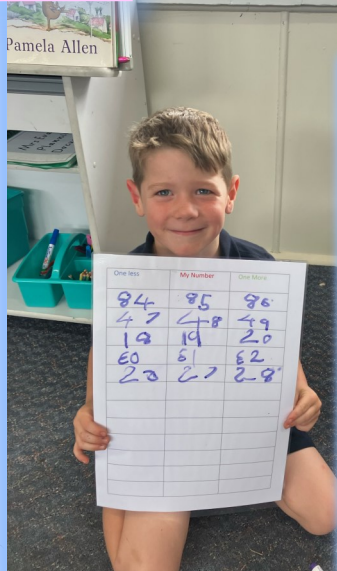
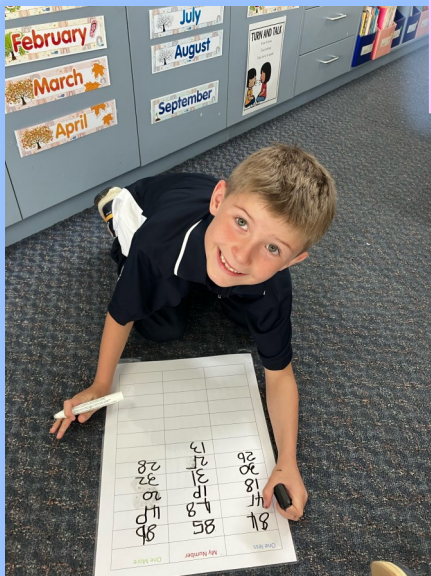

3-6 NEWS

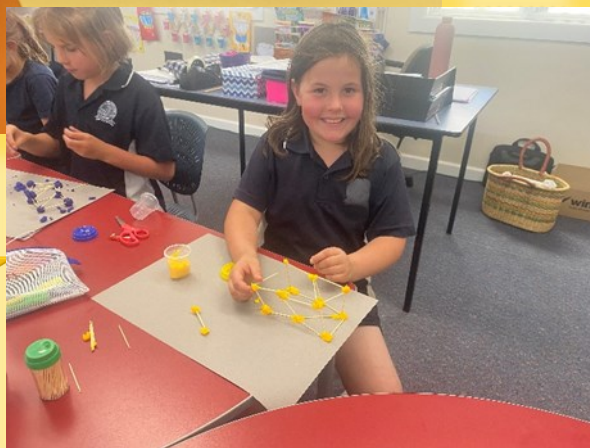
