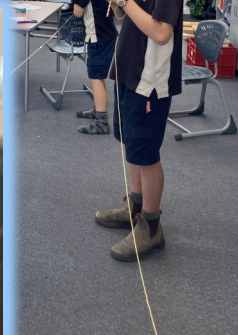
Respect Responsibility Excellence Persistence

Wow! Thank you so much for attending our STEM classroom activity last Thursday afternoon. It was so wonderful to meet parents and grandparents. The students in Grade 3-6 classroom certainly enjoyed cooking choc-chip biscuits and making their ballon rockets with you. We hope you enjoyed the afternoon as much as we all did!

This week we have finished our persuasive writing task and we will be preparing for NAPLAN by completing literacy and numeracy practise tests. We have also started our Reading program. Our weekly reading focus is *"make inferences by reading between the lines to gain a greater understanding of what they are looking at and to reach logical conclusions"*.

In numeracy we have started to explore our new topic Time. Students are learning to tell the time, by $\frac{1}{4}$ to and past, 5-minute intervals and to the minute.

Our Inquiry unit this week has been focusing on how Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people used the land for shelter. Students were given the task to construct a shelter using newspaper, tape and natural materials.
