Thank you to all parents for making the time to discuss your child/children's education with me over the past 2 days. I really appreciate your positive feedback and look forward to continuing working with you and your child next term. A common question that was asked by most of you was "What can I do to support my child/children at home"? Next term weekly readers, spelling words and numeracy tasks will be sent home. Students will be able to complete these tasks during the week and they will be targeted to the learning needs of your child. There is absolutely no pressure for your child to do these, but they will be given to every student in the class.

In Numeracy this week we are focusing on Data and Graphing. Our learning intention is, "To recognise- the features of a graphs, recognise different types of graphs and to interpret different types of graphs". Our inquiry focus is "identifying the different ways Aboriginal cultures use art as a language to document their history". Students have enjoyed painting their own stories incorporating Aboriginal symbols and dots.

Finally, I must congratulate all students for their team spirit and effort last Friday at the school swimming sports. I am so proud of everyone!
