CURRICULUM

The Sounds-Write program continues daily from 9:00 -9:30am. Students work in groups according to their ability levels. In Reading students are focussing on the reading strategy of Questioning to develop a deeper understanding of the text they are reading. In Writing we are working on narratives and in Maths the focus is on Time.

ANZAC ACTIVITIES

On Monday to celebrate ANZAC Day we joined with the senior class to read the book ANZAC Ted, and completed ANZAC Ted directed drawings. They look fabulous and are displayed on the wall near the staffroom. We have also enjoyed making poppies and some yummy ANZAC biscuits.

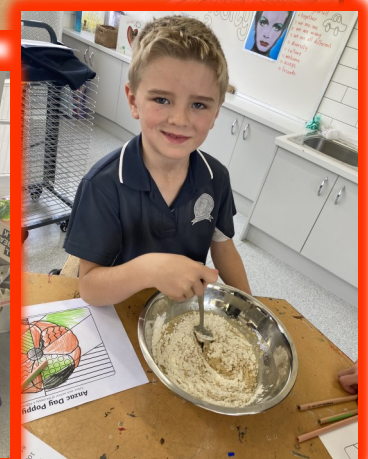

Our numeracy focus is addition. Strategies such as jump, split and compensation have been explored.

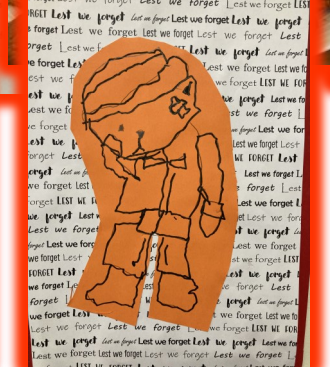
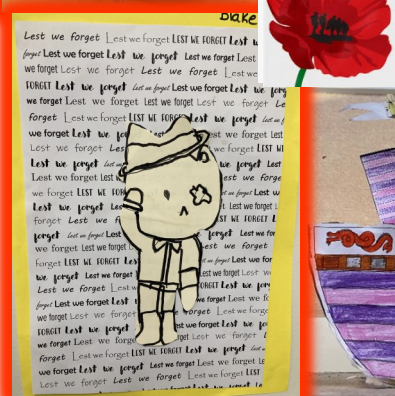
Our Inquiry unit this term is Early Explorers/Australian colonies. We have constructed ships and old ship maps as a lead into this unit of work.
